ACCESSIBILITY INFORMATION



The Mennonite Church USA Orlando 2017 Convention hopes to offer accessibility options to make all attendees feel welcome and be able to participate in a variety of activities. Volunteer Accessibility Hosts will be on site to assist with accessibility services requests. **We thank Anabaptist Disabilities Network (ADN) for coordinating these services.** Here is a list of accessibility services that will be available in Orlando.

Accessibility Information

- For Assistance at the convention, Accessibility Hosts will be available at the Accessibility Services & Information Booth, as well as other resources at the ADN Exhibit Booth. Accessibility Services and ADN booth hours will coincide with the Exhibit Hall hours.
- The Accessibility Services & Information Booth will be located in the main hallway.

Publications & Documents

- A large print program will be available to convention attendees. Please contact the registrar, Sarah Chase at sarahc@mennoniteusa.org to reserve a copy of the large print program by June 12, 2017. *There will also be a limited number of copies available at the ADN and Information Booth.*
- Worship sermons and seminar content will be available in print for as many presentations as possible.

Hotels & Facilities

- If you need an ADA compliant/accessible hotel room, please contact the hotels directly to specify your needs. All hotel rooms include a mini refrigerator.
- The Rosen Plaza Hotel offers the closest walking distance to the convention area we will be using.
- The Orange County Convention Center is a very open and accessible facility. There are restrooms available close to any of the convention activity locations. Maps are available in the program book showing where restrooms are located.
- Accessible parking is available behind the West Concourse building.
- A quiet room will be available for anyone needing some time away from the crowd and noise.

Seating for Worship & Meals

- There will be designated seating available for the worship services. Please plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to the service start time. Accessible seating is on a first come, first served basis.
